



Walter Douglas "Doug" Gandy

August 11, 1949 - September 19, 2007

A memorial service for Walter Douglas "Doug" Gandy, 58, will be held at 11:00 a.m. Friday, September 21, 2007 at the First Presbyterian Church. The Rev. Mr. Gandy died Wednesday, September 19, 2007. Born in Hartsville, SC, he was a son of Loree Harrington Gandy and the late James W. Gandy. He graduated from Hartsville High School in 1967, then attended Wingate College, and afterward spent two years during the Viet Nam War in combat deployment on the Bon Homme Richard aircraft carrier. Upon his return, he became a lifelong painter of buildings, inside and out. He enjoyed Boy Scouts and Pony League Baseball as a child. Later he was much interested in watching ball games and auto racing on TV. He also enjoyed very much being with his friends, activities with his nephews, and swimming and boating on Black Creek. Fishing was his favorite pastime. He also took pride in identifying fish, birds, butterflies, moths and snakes.

Surviving are his mother; sister, Gail Gandy; brother and sister-in-law, Phil and Nancy Gandy; sister-in-law, Jan Galloway; nephews, Phillip Gandy, Ben Gandy, and William Gandy; and his beloved cat, Leo. He was preceded in death by his younger brother, Jim Gandy.
