Funeral services for Wayne Manly King, 72, will be held at 3:00 p.m. Saturday, August 18, 2007 at Ashland United Methodist Church. The Revs. Ricky Howell and Tom Rutan will officiate with burial in Magnolia Cemetery directed by Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home. The family will receive friends Friday, August 17, 2007 from 5-6 p.m. at the residence, 312 Hinnant Lane, and also Saturday from 2-3 p.m. at the Ashland United Methodist Church Fellowship Hall. Memorial services will also be held at 1:00 p.m. Friday, August 24, 2007 at Little Church on the Lane (Charlotte, NC) with a visitation from noon to 1:00 p.m. at the church.

Mr. King died Wednesday, August 15, 2007. Born in Florence, SC, he was a son of the late Carroll Garrett and Forrest Harrison King. He was a graduate of Wofford College, lettered in football, was a member of the SAE fraternity, on the dean's list, commissioned a 2nd Lt. in the U. S. Army, and was president of his senior class. He was a member of the Moravian Little Church on the Lane, in Charlotte, NC, where he had served as a trustee for many years and also as a Stephen minister. He retired after thirty years of service as a vice-president of the Bank of America. After living in Charlotte for over forty years, he retired to Hartsville, SC.

Surviving are his wife, Rebecca Gatlin King of Hartsville, SC; son, David Wayne King of Raleigh, NC. He was preceded in death by his first spouse, Elizabeth Cly King.
