Mrs. Bell, widow of Thomas James Bell, Sr. died Monday, July 31, 2006. Born in Scranton, SC, she was a daughter of the late Samuel Tilton and Nettie Cox Kirby. After her marriage she continued her education at Coker College becoming its first married graduate in 1939. She was a member of the First Baptist Church where she was active in the choir, Margaret Timmerman Circle, Deborah Sunday School class and many other organizations. She was a member of the Civinette Club for many years. She was employed with the Darlington County School system as a permanent substitute teacher and was a member of the Retired Teacher's Association.

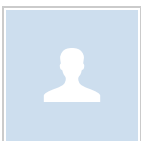
