



Mr. William Banks "Billy" Morrow

It is with deep sorrow that Mrs. Ann Montgomery Morrow and her family announce the death of her beloved husband, Mr. William Banks "Billy" Morrow, 76.

Mr. Morrow entered into rest on Sunday, September 10, 2023, with his family at his side. The Directors of Hancock-Elmore-Hill Funeral Home are caring for the family.

He also had a great love for photography and dogs. He would often take his dog, "CoCo," for a ride. Billy had an extraordinary talent for being able to fix or do anything. He enjoyed cooking his Billy fries for his church family and friends.

A true Renaissance man, his many passions included building car engines (and teaching anything car-related), building houses, sewing, photography, NASCAR every Sunday, and anything that had to do with racing.

He is survived by his loving wife of 51 years, Ann Merritt Montgomery Morrow of Bishopville, SC; daughters, Merritt Morrow Horton (Chad) of Bishopville, SC, and Roslyn Morrow Moore (Tim) of Camden, SC; his dog, Coco; sister, Kathy Morrow Lewis (Joe) of Bishopville, SC.

In addition to his parents, Hubert and Isabel Morrow, he was preceded in death by his brother, Mike Morrow.

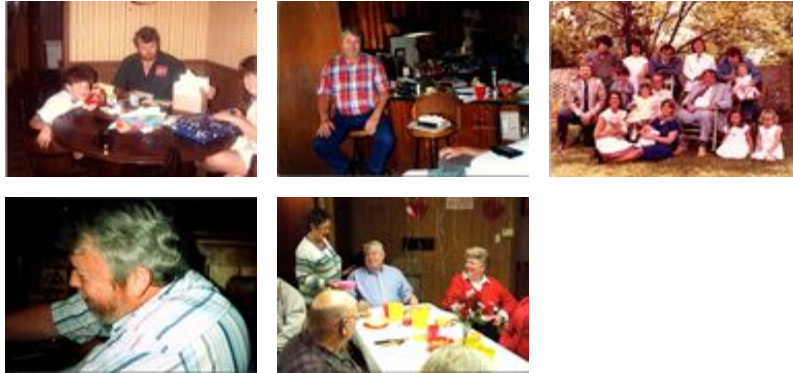

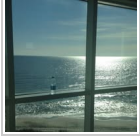
