It is with deep sorrow that the Barnett family announces the death of Mr. William "Bill" Wade Barnett, 63.

Mr. Barnett entered into rest on Saturday, January 17, 2026. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

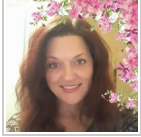

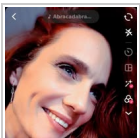

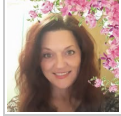
