He proved to be a great mentor & a friend. When my book was published, I needed written permission to use a person's real name. Bill willingly gave it. His birthday, August 12, was the date of one of the most traumatic events we ever experienced in Vietnam. We were on LZ Becky when the NVA tried to overrun it. Our bunker took a direct hit from a rocket & Bill was injured but others died. He & I kept in touch over the last 10 years as I have done with other men I served with in combat in Vietnam.
