G. Sloan of Spartanburg, SC ; six grandsons, one granddaughter, two great-grandsons, one great-granddaughter.

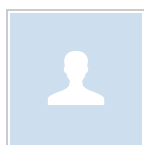

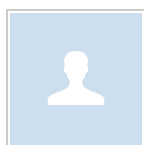
