Known to his friends as Bill, this man was a lover of life. He served his country as a U.S. Marine during World War II. Afterward, Bill was in the Merchant Marines, serving in the engine room of a sea-going tugboat. He married the love of his life in 1950. When his daughter was born, he stayed off the boat and sold insurance for the John Hancock Company in New York. He sold for Durham Life Company once he moved his family to Mt. Pleasant, SC. He loved to go fishing with his daughter, hunting with his son, square dancing with his wife, and playing music with his other daughter. He was a Master of Etiwan Masonic Lodge No. 95 in Mt. Pleasant. His faith was always important. He was a member of Christ Church in Mt. Pleasant and Holy Cross on Sullivan's Island. He was a vestryman, Sunday School teacher, and president of the Men's Club. He was a licensed lay reader

for the Diocese of SC for 54 years, When he retired, he was licensed by Holy Cross to serve communion at Franke Home, Sandpiper Villiage, and Mt. Pleasant Manor. Papa Oldland was the man, the merrymaker, poker player, piano player, entertainer, joke teller (clean and dirty), singer, dancer, husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. We are glad that your suffering is over. We'll see you again with Jesus.

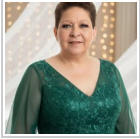
