Mr. Robinson entered into rest on Thursday, October 3, 2024. The Directors of Brown-Pennington-Atkins Funeral Home & Crematory are caring for the family.

A graveside funeral service to honor his life will be held at 11 o'clock on Wednesday, October 9, 2024, in Magnolia Cemetery, with The Rev. Jim Murray officiating.
