Funeral services for William Henry Lloyd, Sr., 89, will be held at 4:00 p.m. Friday, May 16, 2008 at Mt. Elon Baptist Church. Mr. Lloyd, widow of Miriam Gainey Lloyd, died Tuesday, May 13, 2008. Born in Lydia, SC, he was a son of the late George Levi and Mattie Saverance Lloyd. He graduated from Lydia High School and was a Staff Sgt. in the U. S. Army during World War II, serving in nine countries. He was a lifetime member of Mt. Elon Baptist Church and served as chairman of the deacons and church treasurer. He was owner of Lloyd's of Lydia and co-owner of The Fisherman's Corner. He farmed his entire life until the 1980's and then grew and sold tomatoes on the honor system. He devoted his entire life to God, family, country and farming.

Surviving are his sons and daughter-in-law, Tommy and Becky Lloyd, Billy Lloyd, all of Lydia, SC; daughter, Susan Lloyd of Lydia, SC; granddaughter, Missy Lloyd Spencer; great-grandson, Tracy Spencer; faithful companions, Rowdy and Honey. He was preceded in death by his brothers, Mallie Lloyd and Weldon Lloyd; sisters, Corrie Mae Robinette, Rhea Baxley, and Margaret McCalla.
